a) Village Forum / Community Board

b) Franklin Fields (Play Area committee / Transfer of ownership / Pavilion/ Usage)

- The Clerk has received an email from Michael Broad asking for confirmation that the Parish Council is still seeking a transfer of Ownership of Franklin Fields
- The Clerk confirmed that the Insurance Company see no problem with the organising of fun run in Chartridge so long as a Risk Assessment is completed.
- The Clerk to contact Martin Field to trim around the Trim Trail and the exterior of the Playground

c) Horse Riding Signage – Bellingdon

- Cllr Savvides confirmed that a petition is being arranged for installation of Horse signs
- Cllr Savvides has also provided the petition for the nurse to also ask for warning signs for crossing near the Nursery

d) Littering – D of E / Scouts
